HIV Peer Training Program Launched

The value of peer support has been widely recognized in improving the health of patients living with chronic diseases and behavioral health conditions.

BPHC has provided funding to support a collaboration between BronxWorks and Health People to launch an "HIV Peer Training" program. This initiative provides community members living with HIV with new job skills and paid experience while connecting people with HIV to peer support that can drive adherence to their care plans.

"Peer Educators are uniquely qualified to meet clients where they are and give them the support, encouragement and links to needed resources," says Kendra Oke, Program Coordinator at Health People.

To date, 18 peer interns have been placed at six organizations in roles that include outreach, education, individual and group support, and advocacy. Full story.
